A FRESHLY CUT LAWN

Be sure to **cut your lawn one or two days before** the work begins so that the lawn is very short, because very short grass allows us to find and pick up nails on the ground using a giant magnet.



YARD CLEANLINESS

Get your yard ready for the work (remove any animal excrement, cut branches, boards, etc.) so that nothing will impede placement of protective tarps. This will also prevent them from being soiled or damaged.



SAFETY PERIMETER

Ensure that **no vehicle**, **outdoor furniture or object of value** is located near the work area, at least **15 minutes before the workers arrive**. Ensure that your property is surrounded by a clearance zone of approximately 30 feet (9.15 m).



THE RIGHT TIME

Plan for a fairly broad **period of availability** to allow us to protect our workers and your investment, since we have to postpone the work if conditions are not favourable (extreme heat, 60% or higher chance of rain, or temperatures near the freezing point).



Be sure that you can be easily reached by telephone at all times during the work. If workers discover defects when removing the old roof covering, they will need to obtain your authorization to take corrective measures, or for other reasons.



For the comfort and wellbeing of our workers, we ask you to kindly provide access to a garden hose and, if the situation allows, to toilet facilities. Your collaboration will be greatly appreciated.
